Warren Phillips Lodge donated Two Hundred and fifty Dollars (\$250.00) to the 50/50 Scholarship fund. Fifty dollars (\$50.00) were given to the Masters and Wardens Association for the Christmas Dinner, twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) was given to the DeMalay, one hundred dollars to the Pinetree Camp for Handicap children, and fifty dollars (\$50.00) to the local Grange.
